Dear Members,

It has come to my attention in recent weeks that Amateur Boxing Scotland affiliated clubs may be in some way involved in what is known as "White Collar Boxing".

These boxing events, as far as I can see, are not licensed or subject to any scrutiny from the British Boxing Board of Control or any other recognised body.

My primary concern is the reputation of amateur boxing and in particular Amateur Boxing Scotland Limited ("ABS") and the clubs affiliated to ABS. I am also mindful that the participants in these events may not be afforded the best sanitary measures and may be subject to injury. As such, I would ask that any clubs currently involved in any form, including but not limited to, the provision of training, the lease of equipment or expertise to white collar boxing, withdraw with immediate effect and notifies ABS.

It is the duty of the Club Secretary to ensure that every member of their respective club has received a copy of this letter.
